



QUEENSLAND CATCH PRIVACY POLICY

The Queensland Catch Club – an initiative of the Queensland Seafood Industry Association (QSIA) respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy describes the information Queensland Catch collects, and the manner in which it may use such information.

Queensland Catch may modify or supplement this Privacy Policy from time to time. If there is a change to the Privacy Policy, information will be posted those changes on the website. Queensland Catch is committed to ensuring that to the best of its ability it will meet the issues covered in the [National Privacy Principles](#).

1. COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

Queensland Catch collects information about you in the following manner:

- Member Registration: When you register your Queensland Catch Club membership by filling out the membership application form or registration form online, you will be asked to provide certain information about yourself.
- This information include name, mobile, postcode, age range, gender and email address and important issues for you regarding seafood.
- Cookies/IP Addresses: The Queensland Catch primary website, www.queenslandcatch.com.au and does not collect permanent cookies or track you as part of its promotional activities.

2. USE OF INFORMATION BY THE QUEENSLAND CATCH CLUB

Queensland Catch Club will use information to:

- Collect from you in order to provide you with a specific service. For example, your contact information (e.g. email address or mobile number) to provide information on promotion activity across Queensland.
- No individual member will be contacted for any reason other than through the monthly update or to inform you of a win in the Queensland Catch monthly prize draw.
- No third party will have access to individual information provided to Queensland Catch.
- You may contact Queensland Catch Club at QldCatch@qsia.com.au to remove your contact details from our records.

3. WHO WILL SEE OR HAVE ACCESS TO YOUR INFORMATION?

- Queensland Catch may disclose to its members only aggregate anonymous statistics regarding your information which is collected through our websites and printed forms. Other than in this anonymous form, we will never disclose your personal information without first obtaining your permission except as follows – QSIA may disclose personal information if required by law or legal process.

4. SECURITY

Queensland Catch will store all other material that contains personally identifiable information (including application forms) at our premises. These premises are kept secure at all times. All material received by us containing personally identifiable information is destroyed after 12 months or when a member indicates he/she wants to quit club membership.

5. LINKS TO OTHER SITES

The Queensland Catch website may contain advertisements and links to other websites. Queensland Catch is not responsible for the privacy policies or content of third parties. The Queensland Catch privacy policy only address the use and disclosure of information you have provided to Queensland Catch.
